



Dear Valued Internet Customer:

I am pleased to announce that Wildflower Internet has recently purchased the dialup services of Rural Networks. Please be assured that you can continue to use your internet service just as you have in the past. We do however, plan to upgrade spam/virus filtering and add additional payment options - all free of charge.

As of June 1st, 2007, there are a few changes we need to make you aware of. First, please take note of this new support information:

Secondly, we request that any customers who currently pay by check begin mailing payments to: **PO Box 348, Buhler, KS 67522**. We will also offer payment drop-offs at Stewart Hardware Store in Valley Falls. You may also pay/view your bill online at www.wildflower.net/billing. Please be aware that we send invoices 25 days in advance of their due date and that all payments are due the day the service period starts.

Thirdly, we have attached a payment form with this letter. We ask that all customers either fill out this form and fax or mail it back, or you may call our customer support line to identify which form of payment you desire to have. If you sign up for either auto payment method (direct debit or credit card), you will be eligible for a discounted monthly rate of 19.95. Simply write "discount rate" on the form.

We would like to also offer you an opportunity to sign up for high speed DSL service. Our current rate for DSL service in your area is \$29.95 / mo. Please email us or call our 800 number if you wish to sign up. We realize many of our new customers live in rural areas not yet served by our DSL. Please be assured we are working on getting a high speed solution to all of our customers, and please do not hesitate to call in and see if it is available.
